Classroom Materials

All ensemble music will be provided to each choir member. You will be asked to purchase a **notebook paper or spiral notebook and a pencil.** Students will be given 1 notebook to use throughout the year. This folder is for choral music only and will remain in the classroom with the spiral notebook. **Students will also be required to purchase a choir t-shirt for informal performances.**

Fundraising/Fees

There will be a few opportunities throughout the year to participate in additional choir experiences which will be announced as they approach such as auditioned mass choir/ honor. There will be a choir t-shirt which students will be required to wear for informal/school performances. It will be \$10.

It is the conviction of the Avery Trace Choirs that money will not be a factor in any individuals' participation in the choral program. Please come to me with any concerns with costs throughout the year.

Communication

Performance Attire

It is important that we achieve uniformity in all aspects of our performance. Therefore the following attire will be worn for all performances

Formal

White Shirt
Black Pants or Black knee-length skirt
Appropriate Undergarments, parental discretion
Close-toed black shoes/ Black socks

Informal

Jeans, choir t-shirt

Participation/Professionalism

One of the goals of this program is to give students the experience of being professional musicians. This includes having all class materials, keeping up with music, maintaining proper singing posture, and encouraging a positive rehearsal atmosphere.

Each student will be expected to:

- Have Materials (Black notebook/spiral notebook/ pencil)
- Sing with a Positive attitude and Raider spirit
- Work and Support other students

Classroom Rules

- 1. Be respectful
- 2. Be responsible
- 3. No food, drinks, or gum in the choir room (bottled water is permitted and recommended).

Bathroom Passes/Hall Passes

Students will not be allowed to leave the room unless it is an emergency or directed by doctor/parent. Leaving the classroom greatly impacts our rehearsals and slows instruction. Students pass at least 2 bathrooms before entering the choir room, so there is no need to leave during class. All materials will be kept in the classroom.

Consequences

- 1. Verbal warning-documented
- 2. Moved to a designated area within the classroom
- 3. Parents and principal notified of classroom behavior, behavior log
- 4. Referral to principal for immediate action (possible removal from choir).

Grading

60% <u>Daily Class Work (Rehearsal work)</u> – includes quizzes of musicianship skills that show a student's progress, classroom assignments (rhythmic and melodic dictation, music tests, and quizzes).

40% <u>Summative Assessment</u> (<u>Performance</u>) - attendance at all choir performances during school and after school are mandatory and will affect the student's grade. Below is a list of the concert schedule for this school year.
